

# Undergraduate Researcher of the Year

- Description:** The Undergraduate Student Researcher of the Year is given each year to recognize and emphasize excellence in undergraduate research. Other scholarly activities may be considered in the selection process, but the main emphasis will be on research and contributions, with a secondary emphasis on GPA.
- Nomination Materials:**
1. A letter of nomination from the department head or designee, no more than two single-spaced pages, which addresses the criteria listed above.
  2. A three-page narrative that demonstrates the candidate's qualifications for the award.
  3. Abbreviated CV related to the awards criteria.
- Due Date:** Nominations are due to the Humanities and Social Sciences Dean's Office by December 15.
- Recognition:** Recognized at the College Awards Ceremony. Will also be recognized formally during the Student Showcase Celebration during April, the "Undergraduate Research Month."
