NOTICE OF FILING

An application concerning the employment of an alien worker for the following permanent position will be filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for at least 10 consecutive business days, ending between 30 and 180 days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

Position: Assistant Professor (Philosophy)

Duties: Entry-level, tenure-track position. Teach fall and spring courses in philosophy including Environmental Ethics, Philosophy of Religion, and Political Philosophy; engage in research and general scholarship, whether professional or public-oriented, on subjects of political philosophy, epistemology, normative ethics, and philosophy or religion; engage in service at the university, in the community, and in academic philosophy.

Requirements: A doctorate in Philosophy; specialization in ethics or social and political philosophy; demonstrated effectiveness in teaching. Preferred qualifications include: active interest in publicly engaged philosophy; dedication to teaching a wide range of students; demonstrated commitment to student success; particular focus on supporting the access mission of a land-grant institution.

Salary: At least \$62,000. (Utah State University will pay or exceed the prevailing wage, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.)
